## Dear Friend,

I just returned from a two-week trip to Uganda. I was accompanied by Mike Davis, one of our board members. We had a fantastic trip. We could tell stories for hours. We were thrilled to get up close to the people in the villages and watch our professional medical team deliver health education and touch people's lives with tremendous love and kindness.

Four thousand people have water flowing right into their village now. Our wellness clubs have swelled to 1,270 members in just over a year. Virtually no one from the villages we serve goes to the hospital anymore because our medical professionals are right there in the village. Two ladies whose lives would have ended soon are healthy and are now serving as assistants on our medical team — all because you helped us pay for life-saving surgery.

This is what Jesus had in mind when He said, "If you do an act of kindness to someone who cannot help themselves, it is like doing it to Me." (See Matthew 25:40 in the New Testament.)



Then we learned about Alex.

This is Alex. He lives in the village of Sarakihombya. We can only imagine the pain he endures. The humiliation. The despair. He had to drop out of school. His parents are completely helpless. They heard that Ourganda may be able to help so they brought Alex to our team.



## We need to help him.



He needs to go to Mengo Hospital in Kampala. Our team estimates that the cost will come to \$1,000 or so. It could be more, but that's a best guess.

We want to see this boy healed and happy, attending school, helping his parents with chores, and playing soccer with his friends. One hundred percent of whatever you give goes directly to help Alex.
