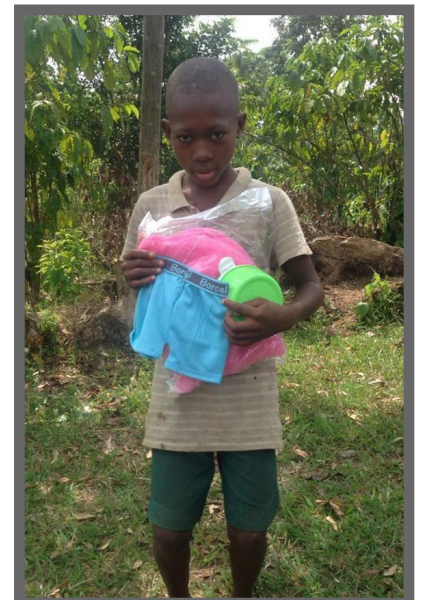

What does a kids kit include? What does \$10 provide in Uganda?

- Shoes & soap
- Mosquito net & underwear
- Dish & bowl
- Flour & fish
- Water bottle
- Toothbrush & toothpaste

All of that for only \$10? Yes!

Vincent’s email concluded: “We thank you. We pray for all of the hands behind this accomplishment. Be blessed!”



We are exceptionally proud of Kylie and Clara for choosing to live unselfishly, for pioneering the Kids Sharing Project, for showing the way and inspiring others to help children in Uganda who have never washed with soap, worn shoes, or brushed their teeth.
