Let's pile on. Let's make this go big!

Act 1: Kylie and Clara started the ball rolling by donating their birthday money. They convinced some friends to get involved. They bought some beautiful water bottles and encouraged people to start saving their coins to help kids in Uganda. Kylie and Clara are now the president and vice president of the Kids Sharing project.



Act 2: Over 100 people agreed to help the cause by filling water bottles with coins. You may be among them!


Since Kylie and Clara got the water bottles six months ago, these pre-teen entrepreneurs have raised \$3,600. Each Kids Kit costs \$10 (and includes shoes, soap, mosquito net, dish and bowl, underwear, flour and fish, toothbrush and toothpaste, and a water bottle). So far, 360 kids have all of these items because Kylie and Clara put their dream to help kids



into action. Most of the kids have shoes for the very first time. They are sleeping under a mosquito net. They can wash with soap!

Act 3: We produced an inspiring, 2-minute video that you can watch here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=qB_oAidr9-w. People all over the world have seen it, and Kylie and Clara are receiving donations for Kids Kits from people thousands of miles away that we have never met.

Act 4: The principal at their public middle school watched the video and said, “Whoa! This is fantastic. How about if we make Kits for Kids a school-wide project for all 760 kids at our school?” The school district approved it, the ASB club agreed, and the dates have been set: February 10–28, 2020.

Act 5: Starts on Monday, February 10, and concludes on Friday, February 28. The kids have set a goal for their fellow students to raise \$2,500 in February.

How about if we pile on and help them? Let’s join **Act 5** and make sure we at least double what the kids at the middle school will collect.
