In the forgotten villages of western Uganda, unnecessary death has been normal for a hundred generations, but it is not normal anymore. Ourganda is rewriting the rules, creating a new reality, winning the fight against unnecessary death.

It is completely wrong to allow unnecessary death when it is so easy to prevent it.

Ourganda saved Zebrina's life. And Agnes's life. And hundreds of others are alive, heathy, and happy because our medical teams roll into their villages every single week with a strong dose of love and hope. Their M.O. is education, medications, and prayer — wrapped in kindness. Right now, our care teams are helping Lonet, Aidah, Kosiya, and Elisa.







Like you, we feel angry when people suffer needlessly. So, we hired the smartest, most compassionate people anywhere. They are in the process (listen to this; this is fantastic) — they are in the process of transforming miserable, desperate villages into human flourishing zones.

And that means this: When you make a generous gift to Ourganda, you change someone's world.
