Big Deal #2:

Our brand-new micro-business team is coming together. Hold on for dear life because in a year or two, all of us will witness a tsunami of entrepreneurs lifting themselves and their families out of poverty. Godfrey is our leader. Juliet is an experienced micro-business leader from Kampala who is coaching Godfrey. For 30



years, Ralph Metzger has inspired thousands of people to start businesses in developing countries all over the world. He and I will be in Bundibugyo next month to help our team create a sustainable, scalable system for moving entire villages away from the brink of imminent financial disaster. We are justifiably excited.

Big Deal #3:

The time has come to build a community center, a unique and functional campus where our teams can teach and model human flourishing.

I wish you could see with your own eyes the absolutely beautiful 3.17 acres of land donors blessed us with. This is the place where the community will gather for sports events, movie nights and classes. It will be a secure location to store the medical vans, medications, and equipment, and our medical and micro-business teams will assemble in the offices and conference rooms to pray and plan. Pregnant moms will receive birthing kits and attend classes on pre-natal care. After dark, families will huddle up and enjoy an outdoor movie in the amphitheater.
