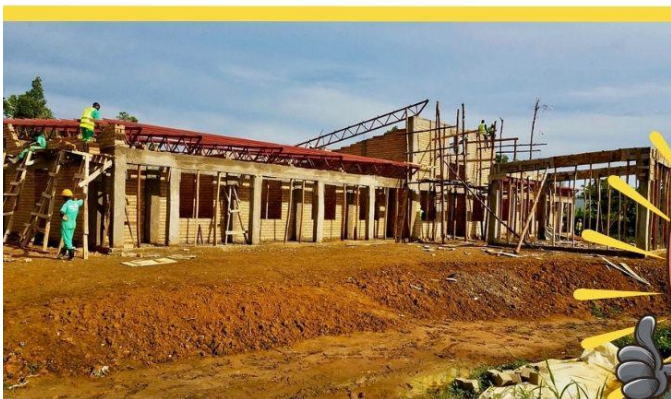

## **A Little History**

- In July 2020, we purchased the most perfect plot of land for Ourganda's future campus.
- In Uganda, most rural property has never been surveyed. Boundaries are determined by families who, over the years, have come to agree on exactly where 'my' land ends and 'yours' begins.
- Ourganda negotiated with five families to purchase the entire 3.1 acres and subsequently had it professionally surveyed.
- A Seattle architect, Brent Lambeth, joined our building committee and designed a facility that Ugandans claim will be the most beautiful building anywhere. Brent's firm prepared the drawings and blueprints.
- Ourganda contracted with Brick by Brick, a Ugandan construction company that has earned a reputation for excellence from government and university clients.
- Before construction started, expenses totaled \$90,081 for land purchase, survey, legal fees, high-quality perimeter fence and gate, engineering approval, structural drawings, and building insurance.
- Once the land was ready and Brick by Brick had the building plans in hand, they presented us with a bid of \$226,000. This includes the main building and outdoor restroom, but excludes furniture and appliances, maintenance shop, paving and landscaping, Garden of Remembrance, video security, and soccer field.





## Construction Begins



- In November 2022, Ourganda transferred our first payment to Brick by Brick. Within a few days, 72 workers converged on our land to start building. As some dug the foundation, others made 50,000 interlocking, stabilized bricks using soil from our site mixed with lime and cement. The walls began to rise.
- Since then, we have paid a total of \$134,000 to Brick by Brick (in addition to the \$90,000 above). As of this month, the steel trusses are going up and the windows and

exterior doors are being installed. As soon as the roof is on (any day now!), we will transfer our next payment of \$44,800.

- When the building is completed in September, we will pay \$33,600; three months after move in, our final payment of \$11,200 is due. (Numbers are approximate due to fluctuating exchange rates.)

## Where Things Stand

- **We have money and pledges to finish the main building. Woohoo!**
- In addition to the \$297,000 our donors have given and the additional \$18,000 in pledges, we still need generous supporters to complete the transformation of this former cocoa orchard into a beautiful, welcoming campus.

Item	Cost	What Does This Gift Do?
Maintenance Shop	\$ 19,000.00	Provides the place and tools to keep our mobile clinics in top condition.
