

Without a solution, she is excluded from school or a job; her life is disrupted and sometimes ruined. A simple hygiene kit is a safe, washable, long-lasting alternative she can count on month after month. Your gift lifts and empowers women to prosper. With your help, we can reach thousands of women everywhere. Period.

When a woman in one of our villages is in labor and makes it to the hospital, she is not admitted unless she arrives with her own birthing kit. That shocking reality partially explains why over 200 moms and babies die every day across the country. Ourganda has received a generous grant for basic birthing kit items, but our team supplements them with a blanket, surgical gloves, maternity pads, soap and extra gauze.

\$6 – supplements 1 birthing kit \$120 - supplements 20 birthing kits





GIVE A WATER BACKPACK

In villages where women and girls have to carry water from far away, a water backpack is a huge blessing. Instead of a 45-pound plastic jerry can balanced on her head or the weight on her neck, she can carry the same amount of water with the weight distributed on her shoulders and back. Everyone loves the water backpacks, and once they experience how awesome these backpacks are, some of the men are stepping up to carry water, too!

\$6 – provides 1 backpack \$60 – provides 10 backpacks





You haven't seen a child this grateful until he or she receives a kit that includes shoes, soap, mosquito net, dish & bowl, underwear, toothbrush & toothpaste, and a water bottle - all in a beautiful bag displaying the Kids Sharing Project logo. No more jiggers in her feet; no more scabies on his head because now he can wash with soap; no more mosquito bites at night. The health benefits are enormous, and the joy on the face of the kids is priceless.

\$14 – buys 1 kid's kit \$70 – buys 5 kid's kits





GIVE THE GIFT OF CLEAN WATER WITH A WATER FILTER



After a long journey with 45 pounds of water on their heads, women arrive at their homes with a jerry can containing polluted water. It's the best they can do unless we provide urgently-needed water filters. At a cost of 4 or 5 trips to Starbucks, you can provide a water filter system (filter, stand, and jerry cans) for three families.

\$42 – provides 1 filter (up to 25 people)

\$420 – provides 10 filters (up to 250 people)

SOCCER BALL & GOALS

The fastest way to gather a crowd of energetic children is to break out a soccer ball. Passing up a morning or two at Starbucks can buy one ball, or you can spread the excitement to a bunch of villages by providing a ball to each of our nine villages. It's time to play!

\$10 – buys 1 soccer ball

\$95 – buys a soccer ball and two net goals for a village







We are nearing the finish line! Everyone – the Ourganda team, the construction workers, and visitors to the campus – declares that this is the most beautiful campus in hundreds of miles. We are almost ready to invite the community to sports events and classes that will ignite hope and model flourishing in the hearts of men, women and kids.

We need your help to wrap things up.

• Furnishings – any amount

A gift of any amount will help fill the conference room, guest rooms, multi-purpose room and offices with tables, beds, desks and chairs.

• Picnic Shelter - \$5,200

This amount provides the funds to build the shelter.

Driveway and Sidewalks – \$24,000

Paving isn't cheap, but it costs a lot less in Uganda than it does in your home town. Help us finish the job.

• Trees & Shrubs - \$1,600

Thanks for helping us put the finishing touches on the dream.

REPLACE MUD HUTS WITH AFFORDABLE PERMANENT HOMES





When the community center is finished, our new construction cluster will begin replacing the mud & sticks huts in our villages with homes made of bricks with a roof that keeps the rain out and a door that locks. How will we bring the cost of a permanent home within the reach of families who work hard and save? Ourganda will hire the construction crew, purchase the tools, and cover 1/3 of the cost of materials as a loan.

- Construction Crew \$12,010 (annual salary for 4 employees)
- Truck and complete set of tools \$10,000
- Place a family in a home \$2,700 (one-third of materials)

SICKLE CELL TESTS

The Bundibugyo District is an epicenter for sickle cell disease (SCD), yet no hospital or clinic for almost 100 miles tests the children. And since 80 percent of the kids with SCD die before their 5th birthday, something has to be done. Ourganda is taking the lead in testing for sickle cell disease. Once a child is diagnosed, he or she can be treated which means another life is saved. Your gift of a box of SCD test strips will directly save the lives of precious children.



BUY A MOTORCYCLE

Ourganda's AWD vehicles constantly transport medical workers and supplies to our villages. Often, however, a sick child or an abused woman needs help way beyond the end of the road. A new Boxer motorcycle costs a bit more than coffee, but imagine sponsoring part or all of the cost of delivering lifesaving service to people our teams could not otherwise reach!

\$1,925 – buys a brand new motorcycle

SPONSOR AN EMERGENCY SURGERY



What does a person do when faced with a life-threatening injury or condition? Unnecessary death is all too common and can often be prevented with surgery. Because of numerous sponsorships, Ourganda has been able to save many lives. Your gift of a surgery gives you the joy of being a person's hero for many years to come.

\$1,000 — covers the average surgery in Uganda

\$500 – pays half of an average surgery

SCHOOL FEES

Every child longs to attend school, but half of them never have the chance because they cannot afford the fees. It's easy to change that. Do the math and quickly decide how many children you would like to send to school every day for an entire year.

\$90 – covers tuition for one student for an entire year

\$450 – covers tuition for five students for an entire year

Micro-Loan - \$100

A gift of \$100 is sufficient seed money for an entrepreneur to get started. When the borrower pays it

back, the money is recycled to a second businessman or woman.

HELP END DOMESTIC VIOLENCE



Ourganda has created a Rapid Response team that springs into action the moment an offense occurs. Our team's leader, Esther, grabs a few Mankind Club members, goes to the home of the offender, and gives him a choice: kindness or prison. With government officials backing her up, the offender's decision has consequences. Out of 250 offenders confronted in 2023, almost all are deciding to be kind. Those who made the wrong choice are in prison or on the run.
