Dear Friend of Ourganda,

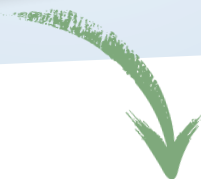
You don't have to actually give up your coffee (unless you're willing to!), but how about matching it for a couple of days, a week, or maybe a month?

GIVE A HYGIENE KIT

Imagine a young woman resorting to rags, banana leaves, feathers or even cow dung to manage her menstruation. Without a solution, she is excluded from school or a job; her life is disrupted and sometimes ruined. A simple hygiene kit is a safe, washable, long-lasting alternative she can count on month after month. Your gift lifts and empowers women to prosper. With your help, we can reach thousands of women everywhere. Period.

\$8 – provides 1 hygiene kit
\$160 – provides 20 hygiene kits

GIFT A BIRTHING KIT

When a woman in one of our villages is in labor and makes it to the hospital, she is not admitted unless she arrives with her own birthing kit. That shocking reality partially explains why over 200 moms and babies die every day across the country. Ourganda has received a generous grant for basic birthing kit items, but our team supplements them with a blanket, surgical gloves, maternity pads, soap and extra gauze.

\$8 – supplements 1 birthing kit
\$160 – supplements 20 birthing kits



GIVE A BABY WELCOME BASKET

Most mothers can't wrap their newborn babies in a clean, soft blanket because they don't have one. In Ourganda's villages, midwives give new moms an incentive to bring their babies to the mobile clinic. Not only does the baby receive an examination, a sickle cell test and postnatal care, but the parents are blessed with a warm blanket, underwear, diaper, socks, cap and a headband for their newest bundle of joy.



\$11 – buys 1 baby welcome basket

\$110 – buys 10 baby welcome baskets

GIVE THE GIFT OF CLEAN WATER WITH A WATER FILTER



After a long journey with 45 pounds of water on their heads, women arrive at their homes with a jerry can containing polluted water. It's the best they can do unless we provide urgently-needed water filters. At a cost of 4 or 5 trips to Starbucks, you can provide a water filter system (filter, stand, and jerry cans) for three families.

\$42 – provides 1 filter (up to 25 people)

\$420 – provides 10 filters (up to 250 people)



GIVE A KID'S KIT

You haven't seen a child this grateful until he or she receives a kit that includes shoes, soap, mosquito net, dish & bowl, underwear, toothbrush & toothpaste, and a water bottle - all in a beautiful bag displaying the Kids Sharing Project logo. No more jiggers in her feet; no more scabies on his head because now he can wash with soap; no more mosquito bites at night. The health benefits are enormous, and the joy on the face of the kids is priceless.

\$14 – buys 1 kid's kit

\$70 – buys 5 kid's kits

SOCCER BALL & GOALS

The fastest way to gather a crowd of energetic children is to break out a soccer ball. Passing up a morning or two at Starbucks can buy one ball, or you can spread the excitement to a bunch of villages by providing a ball to each of our ten villages. It's time to play!

\$10 – buys 1 soccer ball

\$95 – buys a soccer ball and two net goals for a village

DEFEND CHILDREN FROM SEXUAL VIOLENCE



The villages of western Uganda suffer from a disturbingly high prevalence of sexual violence against children. Survivors experience debilitating consequences. In collaboration with local government authorities, attorneys and village leaders, Ourganda provides protection and healing for the child and justice for the perpetrator.

Temporary Foster Homes – \$50 a month

This cares for the financial needs of one child while she is protected by people who love her and are committed to her safety.

Legal Fees – \$70 per victim

Joinus's Team – \$300 a month

This amount provides the salary for Joinus's next team member.



One of the ways Ourganda prepares the next generation for success is establishing children's clubs. Supervised by adults, the clubs are organized according to the structure of the Ugandan government. In each village, girls and boys elect a president, prime minister, minister of justice, minister of health, and minister of education and sports. The clubs' mission is threefold:

- (1) Protection of children
- (2) Projects
- (3) Play

Children develop leadership skills as they learn about their rights and responsibilities, organize to help an elderly widow, watch out for one another's safety, and unleash their creativity and energy in wholesome play.



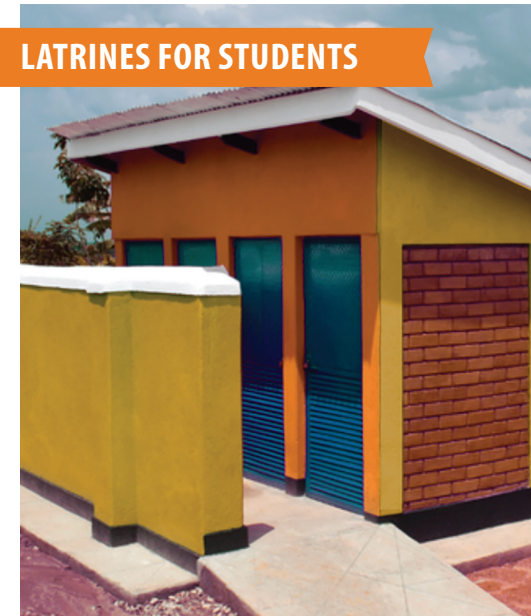
CHILDREN'S PARLIAMENT CLUBS

\$45 – buys T-shirts for five club members

\$120 – allows 20 club members to experience a field trip to Semuliki National Park, the local hospital or a local business.



LATRINES FOR STUDENTS



Unbelievably, many schools in Ourganda's villages have a latrine for the teachers but none for the students. When a child needs to use a toilet or a girl has to change her pads, he/she has to walk home – which often means the end of the school day. In 2025, we hope to end the insanity by building latrines in five schools.

- **Construction Crew – \$6,000**
(annual salary for 2 employees)
- **Truck and complete set of tools – \$10,000**
- **Provide a Latrine – \$3,000**

SICKLE CELL TESTS

The Bundibugyo District is an epicenter for sickle cell disease (SCD), yet no hospital or clinic for almost 100 miles tests the children. And since 80 percent of the kids with SCD die before their 5th birthday, something has to be done. Ourganda is taking the lead in testing for sickle cell disease. Once a child is diagnosed, he or she can be treated which means another life is saved. Your gift of a box of SCD test strips will directly save the lives of precious children.

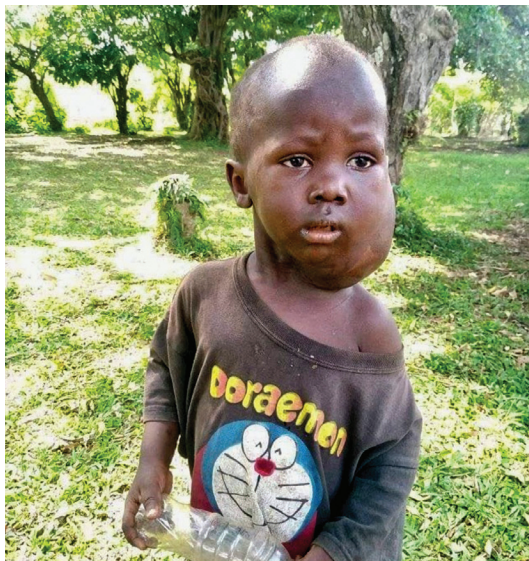


BUY A MOTORCYCLE

Ourganda's AWD vehicles constantly transport medical workers and supplies to our villages. Often, however, a sick child or an abused woman needs help way beyond the end of the road. A new Boxer motorcycle costs a bit more than coffee, but imagine sponsoring part or all of the cost of delivering life-saving service to people our teams could not otherwise reach!

SPONSOR AN EMERGENCY SURGERY



What does a person do when faced with a life-threatening injury or condition? Unnecessary death is all too common and can often be prevented with surgery. Because of numerous sponsorships, Ourganda has been able to save many lives. Your gift of a surgery gives you the joy of being a person's hero for many years to come.

SCHOOL FEES

Every child longs to attend school, but half of them never have the chance because they cannot afford the fees. It's easy to change that. Do the math and quickly decide how many children you would like to send to school every day for an entire year.

EMPOWER AN ENTREPRENEUR



Many people don't need a handout; they need an opportunity. Men, women and young people in our villages are eager to lift themselves from poverty to self-sufficiency. Ourganda's approach is the I'm Possible Pathway, a journey with four components: financial education, savings groups, peer-to-peer coaching and business opportunities. Thank you for matching your coffee purchases to bless one or more entrepreneurs.



\$35 – Tuition for 5 persons to attend the 9-module Financial Literacy Course

\$100 – Micro-Loan

Your gift empowers an entrepreneur to get started. When the borrower pays it back, the money is recycled to the next businessman or woman.

\$120 – Supplies to start a savings group for 20-25 people

WAGING WAR ON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE



Our team leader, Esther, created a Rapid Response team that springs into action the moment an offense occurs. Mankind Club members visit the offender and give him a choice: kindness or prison. Soul Sisters members surround the victim and make sure she is safe and has the support she needs. Out of 750 men confronted so far, almost all have decided to resolve their frustrations with words, not fists. With the backing of government officials, those who made the wrong choice are in prison or on the run.



Mankind & Soul Sisters Clubs – \$17

This amount covers an official T-shirt, ID badge, boots, umbrella and flashlight for one brave volunteer who is solving the domestic violence problem.



Rapid Response Fund – \$100, \$500, or any amount

Your gift helps pay for temporary protection for women and children; food, medications and medical care for victims; and legal fees when a case proceeds to court.
